Abstract:

Restoration of a Roman Statuary Group, representing the God Jupiter

The statuary group (Jupiter Fulminans) is composed of three components: a statuette representing the God Jupiter, an eagle figure and a socket. Its precarious state of conservation imposed a detailed physical - chemical analysis, and the applied restorative treatments required a complex approach. The use of modern restorative methods such as ultrasound, laser or vacuum treatments made this piece regain its shape, chemical and mechanical stability.
