## **SECURITY POLICIES AND INSTITUTIONS IN TRANSNISTRIAN REGION**

<b>Title:</b>	<b>SECURITY POLITICIES AND INSTITUTIONS IN TRANSNISTRIAN REGION</b>
<b>Abstract:</b>	<i>After the end of military operations in 1992, Transnistria has seen a systematic process of creating and strengthening formal state institutions. Although not recognized under international law, the Transnistrian Moldovan Republic (as he titled the separatist institutional architecture) created "de facto" institutions representing sovereignty attributes: customs control, documents for population records, own passports, own currency, minister for Foreign Affairs, bodies of army, police and security services. In this context, security is the cornerstone of asserting claims for the Transnistrian state. What is the status, the logic, the meaning and the performance of institutions providing security in the region? What is the form and how much is contained in it? What are the values they protect and require, and the risks / threats / vulnerabilities that they want to prevent and remove ?</i>
