

Top-Level Learning Experience



Numerous international teachers and mentors from across the EU will come to the Winter School for Female Leadership in the Digital Age to guide students to become the leaders of the future.

These top-level speakers will give the participants a first class education - addressing everything from economics to policymaking and climate change to cybersecurity - during panel discussions, roundtables, workshops, fireside chats and keynote speeches.

Some sessions will be open to local and global accredited media.



28 Renowned Jury Members

The 28 young participants will be selected by a distinguished jury composed of business executives, EU policymakers, professors, senior journalists and equality defenders from all 27 EU Member States and one from the 'Western Balkans 6'.

The jury members will be looking for well-rounded candidates. They will review academic achievements but also the work and interests of candidates outside of the classroom, alongside their desire to learn more about the role of technology in the world.






Winter School in Nice




